- 8. Twelfth Night
- 9. Every Man in His Humor

- II. Identify the authors and the titles of the works from which the following extracts are taken: 20%
 - 1. Give me the map there. Know that we have divided / In three our kingdom: and 'tis our fast intent / To shake all cares and business from our age; / Conferring them on younger strengths, while we / Unburden'd crawl toward death.
 - 2. Some books are to be tasted, others to be swallowed, and some few to be chewed and digested; that is, some books are to be read only in parts; others to be read but cursorily; and some few to be read wholly, and with diligence and attention.
 - 3. Here is a poor burdened sinner. I [Christian] come from the City of Destruction, but am going to Mount Zion, that I may be delivered from the Wrath to come; I would therefore, Sir, since I am informed that by this Gate is the Way thither, know if you are willing to let me in?
 - 4. I was born in the year 1632, in the city of York, of a good family, though not of that country, my father being a foreigner of Bremen who settled first at Hull. He got a good estate by merchandise and, leaving off his trade, lived afterward at York, from whence he had married my mother.
 - 5. My Reconcilement to the Yahoo-kind in general might not be so difficult, if they would be content with those Vices and Follies only which Nature hath entitled them to.

 - 3. What are the differences between a folk epic and an art epic?
 - 4. What are the differences between the renaissance poetry and the metaphysical poetry?

 - 1. Discuss "the three estates," or the three social divisions reflected in Geoffrey Chaucer's *The Canterbury Tales*.
 - 2. Discuss the importance of Christian values in Sir Gawain and the Green Knight.
 - 3. Discuss the carpe diem theme in some famous poems such as Christopher Marlowe's "To His Coy Mistress" and Robert Herrick's "To the Virgins."
 - 4. Chose any of John Donne's poems and discuss the typical features of the metaphysical poetry.
