Read the following passage carefully and write a short "response essay" of about 100-150 words. Your composition will be evaluated on how you formulate and present clearly your own arguments in response to the central ideas presented in this passage.

Lack of sleep is only one drawback to having a "fast-paced" life in our society. Children today are finding "stimulation through exciting activities" and fighting off the tiredness, making them more and more sleep deprived. I've noticed this with my sister, Melanie. Even when she complains about being tired, she always seems to find another activity to do. Just a couple of nights ago, about 10:30 pm, she was whining about needing to go to sleep. She went into her room, turned on the television, and watch TV for another hour and half.

Boredom is another downfall to living a "fast-paced" life. Every day I hear the words "I'm bored" from the toddler that I baby sit. With every video game ever made, several toys and board games, and various movies, kids today are complaining about lack of stimulation. Mitchell, the little boy I baby sit, is only five-years-old and already complaining that he's bored with his toys. I had to ask myself the same question Ronald Dahl asked himself: "How can it be so hard for kids to find something to do when there's never been such a range of stimulating entertainment available to them?" Children are bored with the same old entertainment. The truth is "what creates exhilaration is not going fast, but going faster." Kids need different activities and other forms of entertainment, because they are getting bored too easily.

"Fast-paced" lives can cause several drawbacks including lack of sleep, an increase of stress and boredom. Amid my hectic life, it is clear that we should slow down to help the children with their fast-track lives and trying to find an alternative. I became convinced that nothing can be so important as finding a more balanced path, rediscovering slower, simpler pleasures before we all become burned out and bored to death
