- D. One of the most serious respiratory diseases is influenza, for it is able to attack people of all ages throughout the world. Incidence frequently is highest in young adults. It is an example of a disease that has increased in virulence throughout the years, although since 1942 it seems to have become milder again. Influenza periodically has been epidemic in the United State from 1918 to the present time. Several tragic world-wide pandemics have occurred. One of the most dreadful was the 1918-1919 outbreak, in which there were some 20 million cases of influenza and pneumonia and approximately 850,000 deaths occurred.

Influenza is an acute disease of the respiratory tract that affects the whole body. It is characterized by a sudden onset, with chills, fever around 102° that may rise to 104°, headache, muscular pains, prostration, sore throat, and cough. Like the common cold, it paves the way for secondary infections caused by hemolytic streptococci and pneumonia. Most deaths are due to complications from pneumonia. Recovery is usual in four or five days.
