- 5. How does Ernest Hemingway or William Faulkner deal with the issue of the "woman question" of the earlier twentieth century? Provide examples from the author's works to support your argument.
- 6. How relevant is the theme of the American Dream to ethnic American writers? Cite your favorite writer(s) to illustrate your point.
