PLEASE ANSWER THE FOLLOWING FOUR QUESTIONS AS FULLY & COMPLETELY AS YOU CAN WITH SIGNIFICANT REFERENCE TO HISTORICAL FACTS, DATES, DETAILS, IDEAS, AND PERSONALITIES INVOLVED. IN OTHER WORDS, YOU WILL BE WRITING SHORT, BUT WELL-DEVELOPED ESSAYS FOR EACH QUESTION. (TOTAL POINTS = 100)

- 1. When Thomas Jefferson wrote his <u>first</u> draft of the American Declaration of Independence, he said people have "certain unalienable rights; that among these are <u>life</u>, <u>liberty</u>, and <u>property</u>." But later, when he revised his final version, he changed his words to say people have "certain unalienable rights; that among these are <u>life</u>, <u>liberty</u>, and the <u>pursuit of happiness</u>." Why do you think Jefferson changed his wording? Explain. (20 pts)
- 2. Considering the global protests and demonstrations against George Bush launching a war against Iraq, and given the fact that the United Nations (UN) refused to support such a war, explain how & why the USA now finds itself fully engaged in a war with Iraq. (30 pts)
- 3. What are the reasons why Bin Laden and Al-Qaeda attacked the United States? What's your opinion about these alleged reasons? Don't forget to include the full historical details of the event now commonly known as "911". (25 pts)
- 4. What was the Watergate Crisis all about during the Nixon administration? Explain. (25 pts)
