II. Reading comprehension questions. 10%

Penguins are popular around the world, primarily for their unusually upright, waddling pace, attractive appearance, and lack of fear of humans. With their appealing characteristics, penguins have commonly been the subject of many books, stories, cartoons and documentary films.

Generally, there are 17 known species of penguins in the world. All of them live exclusively in the Southern Hemisphere and have similar appearance-white fronts and black or blue-grey backs. The colors of their feathers not only make them look like wearing tuxedo suits, but also help them hide from their main **predator** in the sea—the leopard seal. If a leopard seal is swimming below a penguin and looking up from below, it has difficulty distinguishing between a white penguin belly and the reflective water surface. If a leopard seal is swimming above, the penguin's dark back mixing with the sea makes it invisible to the enemy.

Penguins are actually flightless birds, highly adapted for life in the water; yet unlike the other birds, penguins' wings have turned into flippers. In the sea, penguins can swim and dive with a push of their flippers and travel nine meters underwater before surfacing. Most penguins feed on krill, fish, squid and other forms of sea life caught while swimming underwater. On land, penguins use their flippers for fighting and for balancing when they walk. Another unique activity that their flippers make possible is "tobogganing", in which penguins slide on their bellies, row with their feet and control directions with their flippers when traveling over on ice. Penguins use this method of traveling when they are in a hurry.
