- 1. The word *truth* in Middle English is very significant. Sir Gawain in *Sir Gawain and the Green Knight* is "being measured against a moral and Christian ideal of chivalry" or ideal of truth. Please use examples from the text to discuss whether Sir Gawain succeeds in such a contest.
- 2. Besides being defined as an epic, Spenser's masterpiece *The Faerie Queene* can be read as an allegory and a chivalric romance. Do you agree? Please use examples to illustrate and discuss.
- 3. *King Lear* is regarded as "the greatest of Shakespeare's tragedies precisely because of its anguished look into the heart of darkness." The audience is shocked by a "vision of suffering and evil." Can you see flashes of insight into goodness and empathy in this play? How? Do you have admiration for reading or watching this play?
- 4. The introduction to *Paradise Lost* in Norton writes, "For some readers, including Blake and Shelley, Satan is the true hero of the poem." Do you agree? Use examples to discuss.
- 5. It is argued that Romantic poet Coleridge opens up to poetry the realm of "supernatural," of "mystery and magic." Can you use his *The Rime of the Ancient Mariner* to explain?
- 6. How did Tennyson see the rapid industrialization in the Victorian era? Use some of his major poems to discuss.
- 7. Use examples to discuss Virginia Woolf's literary achievements, especially her significant contribution to feminism.
- 8. T. S. Eliot is generally recognized a leading poet in the 20th century. Use some of his poems to discuss some of the major characteristics of modern poetry.
