- 2. Discuss the concepts of "identification" and "misrecognition" in Jacques Lacan's "The Mirror Stage."
- 3. Aldo Leopold's A Sand County Almanac is a seminal text in ecocritical discourses that seek to supplement culture with nature. What does Leopold mean by "Thinking Like a Mountain" and "The Land Ethic"?
- 4. Lawrence Bull says that Said's *Orientalism* is a methodologically-focused and field-defining treatise for colonial and postcolonial studies. What are the main arguments in the book?
- 5. Trace the development of recent critical trends in the field of literary theory.
- 6. What is cultural materialism? Try, if possible, to use either Raymond Williams or Terry Eagleton or Stuart Hall to substantiate your main points.
