- 1. *Beowulf*, probably composed in the eighth century, is viewed as a folk epic, which reflects both Christian tradition and the values of Germanic heroism. Please discuss the major themes in *Beowulf* which are related to Christian tradition and the values of heroism in the Germanic warrior society.
- 2. Please discuss the motifs, symbolism, and allegory in the medieval romance *Sir Gawain and the Green Knight*.
- 3. In *The Canterbury Tales*, Geoffrey Chaucer uses a fictitious pilgrimage as a framing device for a number of stories. Please describe how this framing device works to structure Chaucer's *The Canterbury Tales* and summarize one of the tales.
- 4. Edmund Spencer described his epic poem, *The Faerie Queen*, as an allegory. Please interpret the characters and adventures in *The Faerie Queen* in terms of the particular virtues and vices they enact or embody.
- 5. Please choose one of Shakespeare's plays, summarize the plot, and discuss the major themes of the play you choose.
- 6. Analyze Christopher Marlowe's drama *Doctor Faustus*, and in your analysis please focus on the character Faustus and the theme of power.
- 7. Describe the features of metaphysical poetry and select one or two poems by John Donne as examples of metaphysical poetry.
