By now, you may understand the basics of the new coronavirus (COVID-19): It's a respiratory disease caused by a new virus, SARS-CoV-2, to which humans do not have immunity. With the increasing number of people being infected, the disease is spreading fast enough to be called a **pandemic**. But there are still plenty of unknowns and lots of rumors. For one thing, there is not a known cure for this new disease. As everyone worries about contracting the disease, you may hear that you need a doctor's order to get a COVID-19 swab test. Displaying symptoms like a cough or fever is generally not enough for a healthy person to get a test. Those who are already hospitalized with chronic conditions, or have been recently exposed to an infected person or region will take priority in getting tested.

The fact is: Regardless of whether or not you think you are eligible for a test, if you are concerned about having COVID-19, you should contact your healthcare provider. They can tell you the appropriate next steps based on your history and the area where you live. The goal for developing more tests is to test everybody who needs to be tested. However, some doctors would recommend, for the time being, cancelling all non-essential in-person doctor's appointments. Luckily, many health systems are now providing free virtual visits, allowing you to see your doctor from home. Also, do your part to help stop the spread of COVID-19 by staying at home as much as possible, maintaining good social distance, wearing a mask when necessary, and washing your hands frequently.
